Nonstop flights to Berlin: now operating from London Heathrow

From 29 March 2009 Lufthansa will replace the flights to Berlin from London City with flights from London Heathrow. The weekly frequency will then also rise from 18 to 21 flights. And because the larger Airbus A319 will now be used on this route, additional seat capacity will also be available. At London Heathrow Airport business travellers will enjoy the amenities of both a Business Lounge and a Senator Lounge.

Increase in flights from London to Munich

Lufthansa is increasing the frequency of daily flights from London Heathrow to its Munich hub to eight with effect from 29 March 2009. Passengers can catch an early morning flight and arrive in Munich before 09.00 local time. A new evening flight leaves Heathrow at 20.05, ideal for benefiting from a full day in the UK.

Munich is ideal for connections from UK regional airports too, with 20 or more flights a week from both Manchester and Birmingham, as well as 20 weekly flights from London City Airport.
